The rental of a Club boat for a series, course or casually has a few conditions that must be met:

1. The skipper and crew must be financial members of WSC, hold a valid sail pass or be registered for a WSC training course.
2. The allocated boat is available to be used for competing/participating in races on the selected series/course but cannot be used on any other days by the renters.
3. If you have not claimed and begun rigging your allocated club boat by 11.30am on a race day, it may be allocated to another club member for casual rental on that day.
4. Training programs will have priority over the use of club boats on Saturday mornings.
5. The club boat is only to be used in an activity under the supervision of at least one rescue boat.
6. General maintenance of the boat is undertaken by WSC. Any damage or loss of fittings or equipment needs to be reported immediately to a member of the Sailing Committee, Sailing Development Committee, or the Vice Commodore.
7. Where damage is sustained to the club boat that results in an insurance claim, the user may be responsible for paying the insurance excess, **\$100.00**
8. The use of the club boat is for one full race series or training course or single day.
9. The approval of club boat rental is at the discretion of the Sailing Committee.

Please send this application form to secretary@williamstownsailingclub.org.au or present to a Sailing Committee member on day of rental. Payment of the fee must be made prior to use of the club boat.

A member who hires a club boat for a Series must also email the club scorer or Vice Commodore (i) registering their intent to sail in that Series and (ii) providing the name of their crew member. The boat will then be available for sign-on on the canteen ClubOps tablet and the skipper will accrue a score in the Series.

A member who hires a club boat casually for a single day to participate in racing will not receive a score for any race. They must sign on/off using the casual entrant form.
